Keeping Parents and Babies Together

Bleary from anesthesia, Catherine held her newborn daughter for a few precious minutes before Sadie was whisked away to a helicopter bound for Children's National Hospital. Thanks to our new NICVIEW system, Catherine was able to get a crystal clear view of her baby while recuperating in a hospital bed miles away.

NICVIEW cameras allow parents to stay connected to their child and visually check in on their progress when they can't be by their bedside. This system is especially impactful for mothers like Catherine who recover from C-sections in their local hospitals while their newborn children are being cared for at Children's National.

"It's been a lifesaver for her, because she would have been a nervous wreck wondering what was going on," says Catherine's husband, Brian. "It's great for her to have an eye on Sadie and see what's going on and just be able to know what is happening."

Your generosity enabled us to provide a NICVIEW camera in every room in our neonatal intensive care unit where we provide the No. 1 ranked newborn care in the country. Since the system was installed, up to 30 families a week log in to view secure, live streaming video of their babies.



You Keep Families Connected During the Pandemic

NICVIEW cameras have been invaluable during the coronavirus pandemic, which has turned families' lives upside down. A NICU stay can create more trauma, as increased safety protocols limit time with a newborn. At our hospital, bedside visitations are limited to one parent at a time. NICVIEW cameras allow the other parent to stay connected. Bedside visits from extended family members have been halted completely, but NICVIEW technology allows these key support networks for our NICU patients and parents to visit virtually. NICVIEW is a wonderful extension of family-centered care. Nurses can send notes and updates directly to families, giving them peace of mind. Families have reported that because of the individualized notes they receive on the app, they feel more connected to their baby's care.

A Vintage Affair

A Vintage Affair celebrated its 23rd year in 2020. This annual Board of Visitors event raised more than \$1.1 million, including \$84,000 to support virtual reality (VR) technology for nurse training.

VR, which creates a simulated environment, is a revolutionary way for our nurses and teams to learn. As the complexity of our patients' needs increase, we will be able to train more nurses in a variety of situations. VR will transform our training and lead to safer, better care and better results. It provides opportunities to experience potential scenarios, such as pediatric advanced life support and a fire in the operating room.

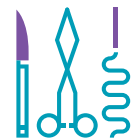
